
Have a wonderful year. May the peace, power, guidance, government, provision, anointing and purpose of God be yours always.

Already in 2017, God has shown us the practical outworking of that teaching, and reinforced that He doesn't call us to do anything He hasn't first enabled or empowered us to do.


The result of having so many God-enabled people in our fellowship includes:

Drought in East Africa

e want to share with you about the heart breaking humanitarian crisis that is currently being faced by many Kenyans as well as a large percentage of East Africa. Severe drought is affecting over 2.7 million people in Kenya, who are facing severe food shortages. The situation is even worse in other countries.

Personally we are seeing water rationing in Nairobi, and we have begun to see the effects at the local supermarket, where items that are regularly available (such as dairy products) are becoming scarce, due to the lack of rain in food producing areas of the country.

Many people are suffering and scientists are suggesting that the



situation will not improve soon, so we urge each of you to join with us in prayer to see the drought over East Africa break and for the land to bear fruit again.
